How to Pay by Credit Card

(Secure online Payment)

- 1. Go to www.learningfield.com.au
- 2. Click on the "parent payments" link in the top navigation bar
- 3. Click on Pay via credit card
- 4. Enter your child's school email address in the field provided (compass code followed by @nhs.vic.edu.au written as abc0123@nhs.vic.edu.au)
- 5. Check that your child's details and the amount of the subscription are correct. If there is a problem, please contact your school's Administration Office
- 6. If the details are correct, click "Next"
- 7. Choose payment method "Credit Card"
- 8. Enter your name and email address to receive an electronic copy of the receipt
- 9. Enter your credit card details
- 10. Check the box to accept LearningField's terms and conditions
- 11. Click "Complete"
- 12. Click "OK" to confirm the purchase and be emailed a copy of your receipt.
