This term in Literacy we are looking at the reading strategies of analysing and critiquing, which will be an exciting focus for the students as they are able to write book reviews and share their opinions on the books they like and don't like. Our writing focus is poetry. Students are already beginning to develop their skills in rhyming and developing poems. In the second half of term students will be writing persuasive pieces.
