Work Experience can ...

- ► Give you authentic experience of the workplace
- Clarify your choice of subjects
- Introduce you to potential connections
- Develop employability skills (for your CV)

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Expectations during work experience

Daily Routine

- ▶ Be on time & stay the distance
- Dress appropriately
- ▶ Be organised for lunch
- Stay safe

▶ Behaviour & Expectations

- ▶ Be a responsible & professional colleague
- ► Telephone if late or ill (employer AND school)

Reflection
