## Could your child's art be in the 2019 Communities for Children Calendar ?

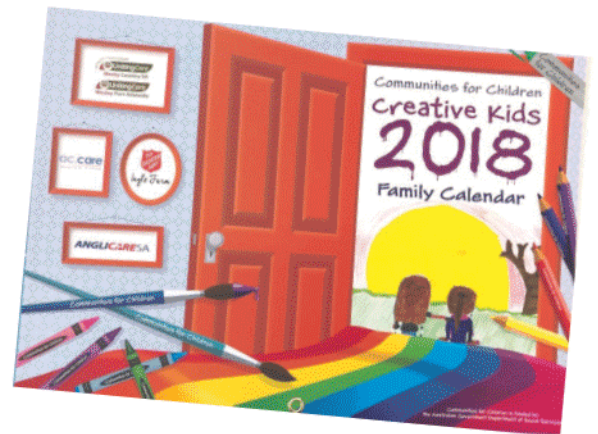
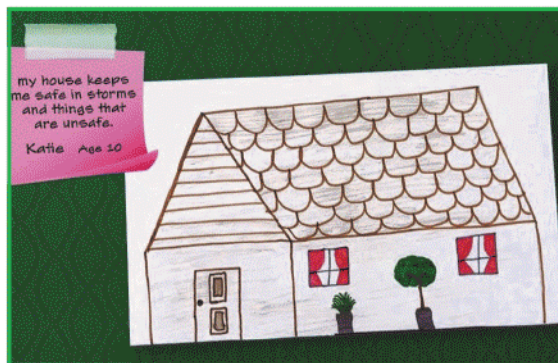

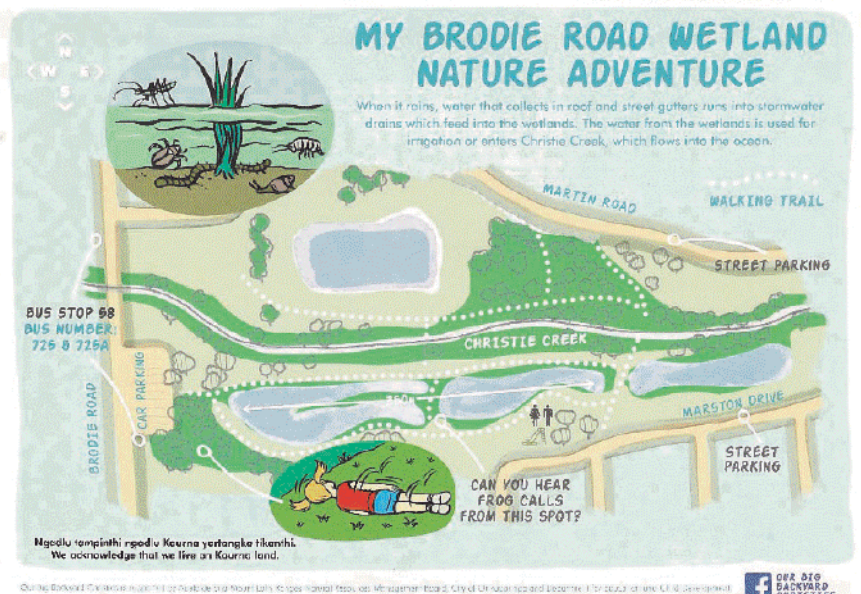
There are 6 activity worksheets and a map that are currently available from AnglicareSA, 111 Beach Road, Christies Beach.

- ◆ Increase physical activity
- ◆ Strengthen family relationships- encouraging parents to play with their children



Our Big Backyard Christies is a collaborative project coordinated by key stakeholders in the Onkaparinga region including Adelaide and Mount Lofty Ranges Natural Resources, (NRM Education team) the City of Onkaparinga, ten local DECD primary schools, kindergartens and Children Centres, Communities for Children Onkaparinga Anglicare SA and other local organisations.





# Southern Children's Festival



**In February this year, over 1000 local community members attended a brand new festival especially for children held in Ramsay Place at Noarlunga Centre.**

Headlined by popular children's singer Peter Combe, the one day festival also featured performances by Sea Star Rock, The Funny Farmers and Mickster The Trickster.

The festival was an opportunity to celebrate children here in our community and it reflected the things that children tell us that they really enjoy doing with their families.

It was AnglicareSA's Communities for Childrens sixth Child Friendly event and the fourth event that we partnered with Country Arts SA.

The Southern Children's Festival provided an opportunity for families in the area to come together and increase their sense of belonging within their community.

Throughout the day families enjoyed a range of activities to suit every age and interest such as Kondoli the Whale, Country Arts SA's DanceXtend Jungle Gym, an animal farm, balloon twister, giant games, craft tables and stalls by local organisations, children's hand print art making, a smoothie making station, book readings, a sensory and quiet area, a photo booth, face painters and even a rock-climbing wall.

# How to make Salt Dough

Salt dough is easy to make. You could paint your salt dough decorations with acrylic paint and decorate with coloured ribbons and some glitter.

## What you'll need:

1 cup salt  
2 cups plain flour  
1 cup water  
an oven  
acrylic paints and varnish/polyurethane spray (optional)

## What to do:

Mix dry ingredients, add water and stir. Knead mixture until it forms a dough consistency. Make your creations or use cookie cutters to make shapes. Bake in oven at 180 degrees until dough has dried.

## Tips

The amount of time needed to bake depends on the size and thickness of the salt dough creations. Salt dough shapes can also be air dried. Once dry, you can decorate with paint.



## chewy Anzac biscuits

## What you'll need:

2 cups plain flour  
2 cups rolled oats  
2 cups desiccated coconut  
1 1/2 cups brown sugar  
1 cup butter  
4 Tbs golden syrup  
2 tsp bicarbonate of soda  
2 Tbs boiling water  
Biscuit trays

## What to do:

1. Preheat oven to 160°C (140°C fan-forced). Lay baking paper over the biscuit trays ready to go.
2. Put the flour, oats, coconut and brown sugar into a mixing bowl and stir well with a wooden spoon. Smash out any lumps in the brown sugar.
3. Put the butter and golden syrup in a saucepan over low heat, stir regularly with a wooden spoon until melted through. Remove from heat.
4. Mix the bicarbonate of soda and water together and add to the butter mixture in the saucepan.
5. Roll the mixture into balls about 2cm round. Place on the biscuit trays roughly 5cm apart. Wash and dry your hands and then flatten down the balls well.
6. Put into the oven for about 10 minutes. Remove and cool on wire racks.

It will bubble and froth. Quickly add the frothy mixture to the dry ingredients in the mixing bowl and mix everything together really well.




5. Roll the mixture into balls about 2cm round. Place on the biscuit trays roughly 5cm apart. Wash and dry your hands and then flatten down the balls well.

6. Put into the oven for about 10 minutes. Remove and cool on wire racks.
