The SDN roster is completed and all debaters have received a hard copy of their rostered on debate nights. Training commences Week 1 and every team will have their 30 minutes before school training this week as well as their Friday afternoon training from 3.30 – 5pm for ALL debaters. At 5pm debaters rostered on for the night will travel to the allocated venue. IT IS VITAL THAT ALL DEBATERS BRING AN EXTRA SANDWICH AND DRINK ON FRIDAY NIGHTS AS THERE WILL BE NO TIME TO TRAVEL TO WESTFIELD BEFORE WE TRAVEL TO OUR DEBATES. The early coin toss (5.30) means that we will not have time for Year 7 and 8 to travel to Westfield for their dinner even on the nights that we are hosting so it should be a routine for all debaters to bring their supper to school on Fridays.

At 5pm the coaches rostered on for the night will travel to the venues. The SDN venues are typically closer to Chatswood so our travelling time will be reduced. Our first debate at Roseville College is on the first Friday of Term 3, 21st July.

St Pius X participates in the Schools Debating Network (SDN) Competition run from Week 1 to Week 7 in Term 3. This 7 round competition runs in Term 3 every Friday night from 21st July to 8th September. There will then be a Tiebreaker and Final round.


