	$\oplus$	Nominations may be for an individual or a group of young people.
	$\oplus$	Volunteering activities may have occurred within or outside the shire and could include volunteering overseas.
	$\oplus$	Helps to care for someone who has an illness, a disability, a mental health issue or who has an alcohol or other drug problem.
	$\oplus$	The person they help care for might be a parent, sibling, grandparent or other relative, or maybe a friend.
Youth Leadership Award in the Workplace	$\oplus$	Full time or part time employment.
	$\oplus$	Outstanding personal achievement within the business sector or their traineeship or apprenticeship.
	$\oplus$	Effort and commitment to excelling in their field.
	$\oplus$	Excellent contribution to the business/organisation through leadership.
Youth Leadership Award in Music & the Arts	$\oplus$	Significant participation and leadership in the visual arts. <sup>1</sup> and or in the performing arts <sup>2</sup> .
	$\oplus$	Significant participation and leadership in the music industry.
	$\oplus$	Show exceptional talent in their field.
	$\oplus$	Effort/ commitment and passion to excelling in their field.
	$\oplus$	Shared their talent with community through live performance, exhibitions/installations or workshops.
Youth Leadership Award in Sports & Recreation	$\oplus$	Outstanding commitment and team work.
	$\oplus$	Contributing to the sport (e.g. refereeing, umpiring and coaching).
	$\oplus$	Represented the sport at an elite level.
Youth Leadership Award in the Environment	$\oplus$	Made a significant contribution to the environment through community activity and/or raising awareness to the community.
	$\oplus$	Has shown leadership in sustainable practice and/or campaigning for sustainable causes.
