The results are very encouraging and exhibit a general trend of satisfaction and improvement in the College over the last six years.








SATISFACTION AND COMPARATIVE ATTITUDES















OVERALL TOP 20 STRONGEST INDICATORS






OVERALL TOP 20 WEAKEST INDICATORS
