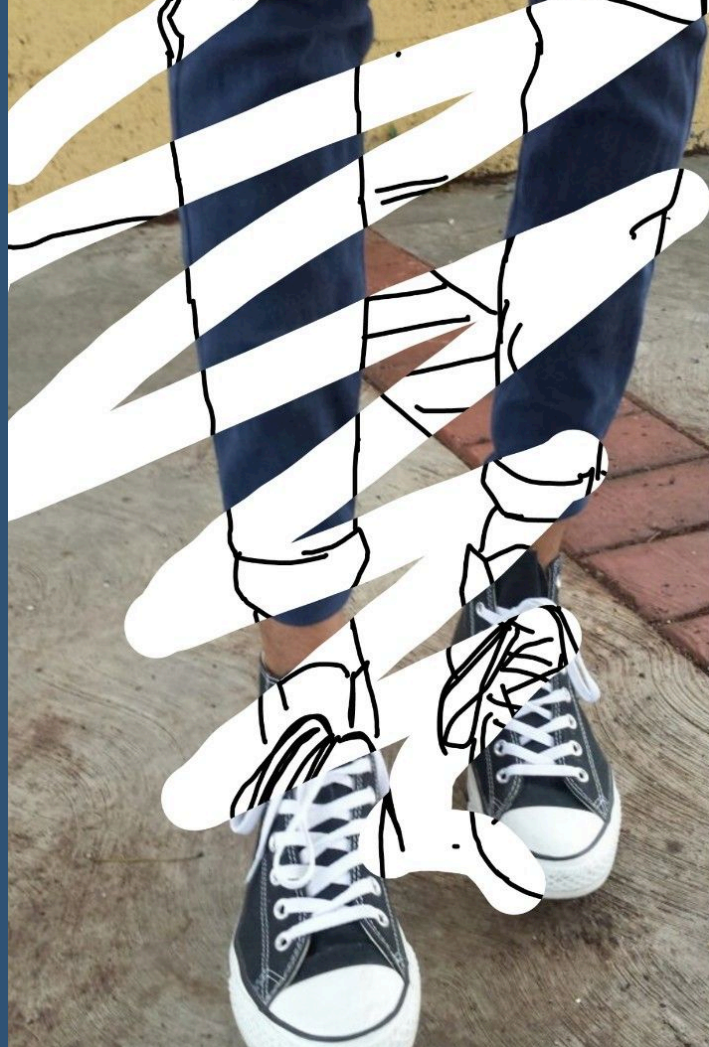
WHAT: An interactive careers session
