TICKETING

Where possible, customers should touch on and off at the beginning and end of their journey. When catching train replacement buses, customers can touch on and off at their connecting train station.

EARLY BIRD TRAIN TRAVEL

Travel is free before 7.15am on a weekday, if you touch on and off. To receive free travel you need a myki balance of \$0.00 or above to touch on.







BIKES, PETS AND SURFBOARDS

Unfortunately, bicycles, surfboards and animals are not allowed on train replacement buses.

In accordance with the Victorian Fares & Ticketing Manual 2016. Bicycles (except folding bicycles), surfboards and dogs and other pets are not permitted to travel on buses, with the exception of guide dogs, hearing guide dogs, guide dogs in training, animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass and small animals if they are suitably contained.

Planned disruptions to train services

Tuesday 27 December 2016 – Sunday 5 February 2017*
*Normal train services resume Monday 6 February 2017





Major construction is well underway to remove the level crossings at Blackburn Road, Blackburn and Heatherdale Road, Mitcham as part of the Victorian Government's commitment to remove 50 of the most dangerous and congested level crossings across Melbourne.

The removal of these level crossings will improve safety and reduce congestion.

Over six weeks, large scale construction will be undertaken to lower the rail line below Blackburn and Heatherdale roads and build the new Heatherdale Station. Works include:

- > Bulk earthworks to excavate the rail corridor
- Building the new Heatherdale Station to be operational for rail customers on Monday 6 February 2017
- > Constructing the new rail line
- Completing the installation of overhead structures and wiring
- Installing new signalling equipment and removing redundant equipment
- Improving the Blackburn Station precinct with enhancements to the station underpass and entrances.

To allow these works to be carried out safely, disruptions to train services on sections of the Belgrave/Lilydale line are planned from Tuesday 27 December 2016 to the last service on Sunday 5 February 2017. Normal train services will resume on Monday 6 February 2017.

Works will continue around the stations after the rail line re-opens while we complete their transformations.

Local businesses will remain OPEN during the works and we encourage you to shop local.

NIGHT NETWORK

During these works, buses will replace Night Network trains on the Belgrave/Lilydale line every hour from 1am on Saturdays and Sundays.

BUSES WILL REPLACE TRAINS BETWEEN BOX HILL/BLACKBURN AND RINGWOOD

A range of different buses will be operating, including express and stopping all stations services, to help make your journey as direct as possible. Customers should allow an extra 40 minutes travel time.



Before you travel, please familiarise yourself with your local train replacement bus stop. Bus stop location information is available at your station.

Normal train services will resume on Monday 6 February 2017.

Note: works may be carried out on the Belgrave/Lilydale line by other projects, unplanned works, or as part of regular maintenance and renewal programs.




PHASE 2

MONDAY 16 JANUARY – SUNDAY 5 FEBRUARY 2017

Buses will replace trains between **Blackburn*** and Ringwood stations.

- *Buses will replace trains between Box Hill and Ringwood stations on the following dates:
- > from 8.45pm Wednesday 25 January until Friday 27 January
- after 8.45pm each night from Monday 30 January until Friday 3 February
- weekends



Q. Why do trains change termination points during the rail closure?

Normal train services to and from the City will terminate at either Blackburn or Box Hill stations at different times throughout the rail disruption. This will allow for critical works to be undertaken around the Blackburn Station precinct, as well as reduce the operational impact on train services.

Q. What is the most direct way for me to travel on the train replacement buses during the disruption?

Information will be displayed at your station, at train replacement bus stops and will be available online. To plan your journey visit **ptv.vic.gov.au** or call **1800 800 007**.

Q. Why is the rail line closed for an extended period?

The rail line will be closed for 41 days to allow for a major program of works to be completed. These works must be carried out while trains are not running to ensure the safety of our workers and train users.

Q. When will the project be complete?

The level crossings at Blackburn Road, Blackburn and Heatherdale Road, Mitcham will be removed by Monday 6 February 2017. Full project completion is scheduled for mid-2017.

Q. Will there be more rail disruptions as part of the Blackburn and Heatherdale Level Crossing Removal Project?

Further closures are planned in early-mid 2017. Customers will be notified in advance of planned disruptions to train services.

TRAVEL TIP

- > Customers travelling from stations beyond Ringwood: for the most direct train replacement service to the city board the express bus at Ringwood into Box Hill.
- > Weekends: buses will replace all trains between Box Hill and Ringwood stations.
