STAT is a series of tests designed to assess a range of competencies considered important for success in tertiary study. It assesses your ability to think critically and analyse the material given, rather than testing your knowledge of specific academic subjects. STAT is used by many tertiary institutions in Australia as part of their admissions procedure for certain categories of applicants. Generally, these are:

Mature applicants who don't have a recent or standard Year 12 qualification Applicants who completed their previous studies outside Australia Applicants who did not gain a satisfactory ATAR
