Merri Creek Sewer Rehabilitation Project

May 2017

Work in Merri Park and pedestrian/cyclist detour

We will be undertaking essential works in Merri Park in early May and this work is scheduled to be complete by the end of June, weather permitting.

These works will involve rehabilitation of manholes, relining of the sewer and bypass pumping of sewage flows.

What to expect

- Set-up of work areas with temporary fencing
- Heavy vehicles and machinery will access the work area via Sumner Avenue and Eunson Avenue and will travel along footpaths into Merri Park*
- Changes to shared user pathway*
- Bypass pumping in place to divert sewer flows while works take place.
- Construction work hours will be during both the day and night, seven days a week
- Pruning and removal of vegetation and trees as required to access the site.

General information

- We will be using various construction machinery including construction utes, haulage trucks, pumps, generators and mobile cranes

- Temporary fencing will be extended to the ground in dog leash free zones
- Work site will be repaired and reinstated to original condition upon completion of works.
