- A short course sprint track and re-development of the long jump pit to help our athletes expend some energy.
- Outdoor furniture, log seating, rocks and native plants. Quiet places for friends to congregate, chat and play.
- Redevelopment of the sand pit area to include sensory elements, a nature walk and possibly a musical element.
