The one Kerang depot has expanded to 9 depots across the Mallee and the Goulburn Valley.

Fertiliser is still a very large part of the Lipp's business, however the business has also expanded into other facets of agriculture including gypsum, salt, logistics, agronomy, rural retail and merchandise.

Lipp's expanded into the Goulburn Valley in 2016 with the purchase of Ajax Fertilisers. In March 2017 the Incitec Pivot Depot at Congupna was purchased. Business in the Goulburn Valley is growing well, hence the need for the junior position.
