Senior School Student Attendance Requirements 2017 - Year 11

Dear Parent/Guardian

The Senior School Team would like to express our excitement and commitment towards working with your son / daughter during their important and final years at Scoresby Secondary College. We are looking forward to mentoring all our Senior School students and assisting them in making their schooling a positive and productive experience, as we strive for all our students to achieve their personal best.

Below are some important administrative practices relating to attendance that will be in place for our Senior School students this year, which we would like to bring to your attention.

In order to satisfactorily complete any unit of study at the VCE / VCAL level and as per the guidelines of the Victorian Curriculum Assessment Authority (VCAA), we require a student to **attend 90% of classes** within any given unit. Only approved absences do not contribute to the absence total. It is important to clarify that, under VCAA guidelines; a note from a parent / guardian **may not** approve an absence. Medical certificates and / or approval in writing by the College Principal are, however, acceptable for approving an absence under the guidelines.

Therefore, to ensure accuracy with our attendance records, we request that the information presented below be followed by our students and supported by parents / guardians.

- All Year 11 students will be dismissed from the College at 1.10pm on Wednesdays to attend either their VET course or to complete private study off campus. If students wish to remain at the College and study, they will need to sign in at the General Office and remain in the Senior Hub to complete private study.
- Students in Year 11 are not permitted to leave the College early on any other day, except with expressed written permission from the Senior School or College Principal.
- All students are required to be at the College by **8.50am** for the commencement of Period 1. During any study periods, Year 11 students should be in the Senior Hub completing private study.
- Assemblies will be scheduled every second Monday and will commence at 8.35am and students will need to
 ensure that they arrive on time to assembly with all required materials. Students should check their
 Compass news feed for further information regarding assemblies. It is compulsory for all students to be in
 attendance at all assemblies and failure to do so will affect a student's attendance record.

In order for your son/daughter to be permitted to leave the College under the conditions listed above, we require parent / guardian written approval. Please sign the reply slip below and return it to your student's Year Level Coordinator to indicate your acknowledgement and agreement with these terms of attendance.
