
John has spent a lifetime working in education.

John is also a senior consultant with the Institute of Positive Education, has presented at many conferences including the UNESCO conference on Bullying and School Violence and has worked with various elite sporting clubs such as the Australian Institute of Sport on establishing cultures that enhance athlete health and wellbeing and team performance.
