

## International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS)

Dear Parents,

At this time of year we inform you of some great learning opportunities for your child. The International Competitions and Assessments for Schools (ICAS) are independent skills-based assessments with a competition element. Commonly referred to as the UNSW tests, ICAS is unique, being the most comprehensive generally available suite of academic assessments and school tests for primary and secondary school students. Students can choose to enter any or all of the competitions listed below. All competitions take the form of a formal exam and have a fee per student per exam to enter (see below for applicable entry fees).

These competitions are a great opportunity for your child to participate in something new and or provide a challenge (they are not compulsory). Please consider that the questions get progressively harder throughout the test. These exams are one way to see how your child is progressing with their learning, and may not give a complete picture of your child's abilities.

Each student who participates will receive a certificate and a detailed results letter indicating which questions they answered correctly, as well as the average mark for Victoria. Results will be available to schools approximately 6 - 8 weeks after the sitting date of each subject.
