



Pastured, Free Range Eggs at Thursday Market

We are helping our lovely neighbours, Harley and Will, reach further afield by bringing their beautiful Jindi Free Range Eggs to the after school community markets.

These guys are the real deal - genuine thoughtful care for their livestock's needs, GM-free feed supplements their free access to fresh greens and grass (and bugs), plenty of safe space to forage, dust bathe safe from predators, and eggs are hand collected and graded (fresh to you from the weekend collection). There are less than 200 hens per hectare (compared to the 10,000 per hectare definition brought out this year).

So if you lament buying old eggs at the store, or your chooks are off the lay, drop by and pick up some delicious wholesome egggy goodness.
