UniExperience gives Year 11 students the opportunity to come on-campus and experience university life first-hand. The two-day program demystifies the university experience by giving you the chance to stay at our Parkville campus and take part in a range of sessions covering many aspects of tertiary study.

You are eligible to apply for UniExperience if:

- You attend secondary school in a Victorian regional or border town
- You are the first in family to consider attending university and no members of your immediate family (parents, grandparents or siblings) have been awarded a university qualification
- You identify as Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander.

The program:

- On-site accommodation and meals at one of the University's residential colleges
- Guided campus tours
- Detailed information on the Melbourne curriculum and course offerings
- Course expo where you can ask about the transition to university, student support services, accommodation options and scholarships
- Find out about unique opportunities to enrich your degree such as studying a concurrent diploma, going on exchange and participating in community involvement activities at Melbourne
- Social activities and the opportunity to meet both peers and current university students.

Cost

\$100.00 (including GST) covers all meals, overnight accommodation and all materials relating to the program. Limited bursaries are available.
