Maroondah Youth Film Festival Terms & Conditions

1. All work must be the original work of young people aged 12-25 years of age who live, work, study or recreate in the City of Maroondah. Group/school based submissions are allowed as long as all film makers are aged 12-25
2. The Maroondah Youth Film Festival is a film competition and prizes will be awarded for each category. As such, all entries must be submitted into one of the following categories*;
 - a. Ages 12-15
 - b. Ages 16-18
 - c. Ages 19-25

**please note, if for any reason group entries do not fit into these age categories, please contact us on 9294 5704 to discuss*

3. Winners will be chosen via a panel of judges and all decisions are final. Winners will be announced at the Film Festival to be held on Friday November 24th, more details of the event to be released mid-year. Due to time constraints, it may not be possible to screen all submissions. In this instance, all winning entries will be screened along with a selection chosen by the judging panel.
4. Films must be a G or PG rating. Any films that are deemed to have inappropriate content will not be accepted – this includes films that promote or encourage unsafe or inappropriate behaviour including sexism, discrimination, racism or the use of drugs and/or alcohol.
5. Films must be between 30 seconds – 10 minutes long
6. All application forms and films are due by Friday 27th October 2017 by 5pm. Films must be submitted in MPEG4 (MP4) format on a USB. Please note that we will be unable to return USB's to film makers.
7. All film entries must provide a minimum of 3 high quality still JPEG images from your short film to be used for promotional purposes.
8. All entrants will be notified as to the outcome of their application via email.
9. An APRA license has been obtained which will cover the copyright of the public display of the short film on Friday 24th of November. However, entrants must ensure that they have copyright clearance in regards to the use of non-original material, this includes sound or visual clips. Any films without copyright clearance will not be screened at the film festival.



10. Entrants must obtain written consent from all actors in the film for the use of their performance. This is to be completed as part of the application form. Any actors under the age of 16 years old must obtain a parent or guardian signature on this form.
11. All entrants must ensure that all details on the entry form are true and correct. If you are under the age of 16 years old, your parent or guardian is required to sign the application form.
12. If your film does not meet any of the terms and conditions set out, we will endeavor to contact you so you can choose to edit your film to fit with the requirements, however we are under no obligation to do so.
13. Event organisers reserve the right to not accept or screen films based on the terms and conditions listed above.
