E12 scheme applications are now open!

We write to advise that our Early Offer Year 12 (E12) scheme, which offers a scholarship and ATAR concessions, is now open for applications.

This year, schools are able to each nominate up to 30 students, and students interested in applying for an early offer through the E12 scheme can now choose between <u>74 courses</u>.

If your school is not automatically eligible for E12, we encourage you to identify eligible students from low socio-economic backgrounds who you think meet the selection criteria and in your view would succeed at the University of Sydney.

Please let your students know that the online application is <u>now open on our website</u> and they have until **5pm**, **Friday 1 September 2017** to apply. - 1. Student applies online by 5pm Friday 1 September 2017.
- 2. You will receive an email notification with a link to view their submission.

- 4. Applications are assessed by a selection panel at the University.
