# English Advanced & Standard Area of Study (Discovery) Lecture

(1 Hour 45 Minutes)

Our English Area of Study (Discovery) lecture is designed to ensure that students have all the information they need to **maximise** results in the Area of Study component of the English exams.

During this lecture, students will develop a **strong understanding** of NESA requirements and the Area of Study rubric.

They will examine the skills required to identify Discovery concepts in texts as well as the means by which this process of identification can be supported by technical analysis.

Specific examples of related texts will be analysed, which students will find **highly beneficial** in the course of their studies and in the composition of their own essays.

Clear, achievable goals concerning the Board's requirements will be detailed, with significant attention being paid to the way students should be orientating their efforts towards achieving these goals.
