
The SDN website. http://www.sdndebating.com.au/ has addresses and maps of all schools for parents to check location of pick up.

The SDN season is into its 3rd week this Friday. Congratulations to the Year 7 debaters who are undefeated. SDN is a different system of debating. The structure is more in line with the Archdale and ISDA Debating competitions and the skill set required is more focussed on Matter and Method with little regard for Manner of Speaking. The focus is on strong content argued through effective rebuttal. This week debaters were exploring the different approach needed during the actual debate to identify major 'clashes' or points of contention that are developing DURING the debate and how to merge examples explored during prep time to these 'clashes'.
